



## Nov - Dec 2018 Prayer Points

*The Apostle Paul writes, “<sup>8</sup>Although I am less than the least of all the Lord’s people, this grace was given me: to preach to the Gentiles the boundless riches of Christ, <sup>9</sup>and to make plain to everyone the administration of this mystery, which for ages past was kept hidden in God, who created all things. <sup>10</sup>His intent was that now, through the church, the manifold wisdom of God should be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly realms, <sup>11</sup>according to his eternal purpose that he accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord.” Ephesians 3:8-11 (NIV)*

### Prayer Points

1. We praise God for his eternal purpose which includes us as adopted children. God has become our father, in Christ Jesus.
2. Praise God for making us heirs together with Israel, members of one body and sharers in the promise. God has richly blessed us with Abraham’s blessing, eternal life through faith in Christ Jesus.
3. Pray for Churches that they will have the sense of being in God’s purpose and align their ministries accordingly.
4. Spend time thanking God for choosing to use the church to reveal his manifold wisdom to spiritual forces in the heavenly realms. We are forgiven, cleansed and regenerated with new life for the glory of God.
5. Pray that believers will be strengthened in their inner being to be able to endure difficult times. God’s power within us enables us to go through tough times.
6. Pray for protection of marriages and families in the church and in the nation.
7. Pray for those who serve in the church that God will help them maintain integrity in ministry for the sake of the name of Christ.
8. Pray for the church in Canada to be revived with the life of the Holy Spirit.
9. Pray for the poor and lonely during this Christmas period that they will find hope as the church steps up to feed the hungry and to be with the lonely.
10. Pray for Canada that the Lord will guide leaders to lead the nation well, that politicians will pass legislation that will protect and guide people with godly principles.
